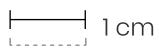




RING SIZING GUIDE

Step 1. Check page scale

To make sure you have printed the right scale, measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 1 cm or 10 mm.



Step 2. Pick a ring

Select a ring that you already own. The ring should properly fit the finger of your choice.

Step 3. Measure the ring size

Place your ring over the circles on the right and move it around until you have found the right size. Pay attention: measure only the inside edge of the ring.

If the ring falls in between two sizes, order the bigger size.

TIPS

Finger sizes change depending on time of the day and weather. Measure your ring size in the evening and when your fingers are warm. Your fingers are smaller in the morning and when it's cold.

Avoid using string or paper as these materials might stretch or twist, which will make the measurement inaccurate.

Before printing, make sure that "Page Scalling" is set to 100% on your dialog box. Make sure to remove "Fit to scale". To open the print dialog box press CTRL+P (CMD+P).
